Schader had started on the pole and taken the lead in his Lola followed by Mahre and Lee Lucas.

After Leslie Clark went off and brought out the pace car, the field closed up, which would prove costly to Schader.

On the restart, Schader took off again with Mahre and Lucas in pursuit. Jeff Glenn spun twice at Turn Seven trying to pass Lucas, dropping him from fourth to 12th. Greg Loebel inherited fourth and held off Larry Vollum and Chris Ronson.

After the penalty, however, the finishing order was Mahre, Lucas, Loebel, Schader, Vollum and Ronson.

In Round 8, Schader took the lead and pulled away, though three cars tangled and brought out a local yellow flag. Lucas then pulled away from Mahre, while Glenn dropped from fourth to 10th with a fouled plug.

Schader checked out, but lapped traffic allowed Mahre to close on Lucas. Mahre

played it safe, however, knowing that with Lucas in second, he had to finish only ninth or better to win the title.

Schader took the victory 28.276 seconds ahead of Lucas with Mahre and Ronson following.
