## ACRL Returns to Mesa Marin Raceway

In 1988, City-Team auto racing burst onto the West Coast sports scene. In this kind of racing, fans and media can identify with their city's team in a rivalry with other cities. San Francisco has the 49ers, Los Angeles has the Dodgers, and San Jose has the Sharks, but no one had ever seen City-Team auto racing. This exciting new sport was introduced by the American City Racing League, the new kid on the block. The ACRL is sanctioned by the Pro Racing Division of the Sports Car Club of America and managed by the ACRL Board of Directors.

There are currently 10 west coast cities represented in the ACRL, allowing spectators to cheer on their favorite city's team. Before qualifying, each team must designate three points-scoring cars. The top two finishing cars from each team score team

The ACRL has two divisions - Super Sports 2000 with Ford Cosworth 2-liter, 16 valve DOHC power, and Sports 2000 using the Ford 2-liter single cam engine. The cars run on Hoosier spec tires and use Daeco racing fuel.

This is ACRL's third race of their 8 race season and the second of two appearances at Mesa Marin. 1995 Team Champion, San Jose leads San Diego, 1994 Champs, by just 9 points. They are challenged by Team Santa Barbara and Team Las Vegas.

Team San Diego's Bob Schader still leads by 16 points after his win at Laguna Seca and 2nd place at Mesa Marin #1. He is followed by San Jose's Lee Lucas, the 1992 & 1993 Driver Champ, and by the 1995 ACRL Rookie of the Year, Jeff Glenn.


The ACRL put on an exciting show earlier this month with a fierce race between oval track specialist and 1995 USAC Ford 2000 Rookie of the Year, Memo Gibley, Team Santa Barbara, who narrowly won over points leader Bob Schader followed by Team Reno's Rick Lee. Peter Zarcades (pole setter by .oo3 seconds) was a hot contender until he found himself in the turn 4 and front straight inside walls. Dicing, sometimes four abreast, were San Jose's Lee Lucas, Jeff Glenn, 1994 ACRL Champion Margie Smith-Haas (Team San Diego) and Team Las Vegas' Leo Sismani.

The S2000 race was a hard fought contest between Team Woodland's Leo Giroski and Santa Barbara's Tom Bungay followed by Team Anaheim's Len Rennick.

Team San Diego's 2nd and 6th place finishes (Schader & Smith-Haas) won the City Cup honors just ahead of Team San Jose who still leads the series team points by just 9 points ahead of Team San Diego.
