Jeff Glenn celebrates ACRL Father's Day win for his Dad

PORTLAND, OR, June 15—It was another happy Father's Day for Steve Glenn, as son Jeff posted a win for Team Beverly Hills in the American City Racing League's second stop at Portland International Raceway.

It was the first ACRL win for the Carbir chassis, sponsored by Bank of the West and Oiltex.

"Jeff has won a race every Father's Day since he's been racing," said proud papa Steve. With teammate Mark Neuhaus' eighth place finish, Beverly Hills also took the team win with 172 points, three ahead of Team Reno.

Glenn qualified on the pole, but Team Reno's Steve Romak got a great start from outside the front row and led the first seven laps. Glenn got by on lap eight and Romak chased him until a missed shift on lap 13 caused a spin, dropping him to fifth. Romak rejoined and passed Portland's Larry Vollum for fourth on the final lap.

Rick Lee, Team Reno, and Peter Zarcades, Team Las Vegas, staged a race-long battle, ending with Lee in second place and Zarcades in third. Another battle for sixth place finally went to Leo Sismani of Team Reno when Romak's Fresno teammate John Ostlund spun in Turn 9 while attempting a pass. San Diego's Bob Young and Neuhaus both got by before Ostlund could recover.

Frank Arnold, the Team Fresno S2000 driver, chased Woodland's Brad Arntson the first part of the race, finally passing him on lap 10 and driving away for his second S2000 win in a row. Arntson finished second in class, holding off San Diego's Ian Wood for the last half of the race.

Twenty-six cars took the grid, 21 Cosworths and five "B" category Sports 2000s. Local communities were well represented with Portland's Larry Vollum's fifth place the highest among them. Team Vancouver, BC, represented Canada with two cars, making it an international field.

Glenn's margin of victory was 6.218 seconds after 22 laps (42.35 miles), completing the race in

30 minutes and 10.77 seconds. Romak set fast lap at 1:16.729 (90.177 mph).
